WHEREAS: While Minnesota has over 3.1 million registered voters, an additional 800,000 citizens

are eligible, but have not yet registered to vote; and

WHEREAS: The voter registration process in Minnesota is easier and more convenient than ever

before with applications available online, and at every state agency and all 87 county offices throughout the state, and other options available such as online voter registration,

same-day registration, and when applying to get a driver's license; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has an online voter registration system enabling citizens to

register, check, and update their registration status; and

WHEREAS: The need for all Minnesotans to stay restless until every eligible citizen is registered to

vote, and uses that vote as their voice in the 2015 and 2016 elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, September 22, 2015, as:

VOTER REGISTRATION DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
