The Honorable Carol A. Hooten, Judge of the Minnesota Court of Appeals has made written application to the Governor by letter dated August 17, 2021, for retirement effective at the close of business on November 30, 2021.

After that date, she will be entitled to retirement compensation as provided under Minnesota Statutes 2020, Chapter 490.
