



IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
THE HONORABLE LORIE S. GILDEA, CHIEF
JUSTICE OF THE MINNESOTA SUPREME
COURT, FOR RETIREMENT UNDER
MINNESOTA STATUTES 2022, SECTION
490.126, SUBDIVISION 2.

The Honorable Lorie S. Gildea, Chief Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court, has made written application to the Governor by letter dated June 15, 2023, for retirement effective at the close of business on October 1, 2023.

The Honorable Lorie S. Gildea has served as the Chief Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court since July 1, 2010. She also served as an Associate Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court from January 11, 2006 to July 1, 2010 and as Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, State of Minnesota, from September 26, 2005 to January 10, 2006.

The Honorable Lorie S. Gildea has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 490.121 to 490.126, for retirement effective at the close of business on October 1, 2023.

For these reasons, I, Tim Walz, the Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 2022, Chapter 490, order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Lorie S. Gildea, Chief Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court, effective at the close of business on October 1, 2023. After that date, she will be entitled to retirement compensation as provided under Minnesota Statutes 2022, Chapter 490.
