IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION BY THE HONORABLE LAWRENCE R. YETKA, JUSTICE OF THE MINNESOTA SUPREME COURT, STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT ON OCTOBER 31, 1994, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF LAWS 1973, CH. 744, SEC. 4, SUBD.2 AND MINNESOTA STATUTES 490.124, SUBD. 2, FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE SAID HONORABLE LAWRENCE R. Carlson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the aforementioned statutes do hereby order the acceptance of such retirement application, and order that the present term of office for said Justice Lawrence R. Yetka be, and it hereby is, extended to and including October 31, 1994 and further order that retirement benefits commence, as provided by law, at the close of business on the 31st day of October, 1994.
