Proclamation

WHEREAS: Edward Stringer, a native of St. Paul, graduated cum laude from Amherst College, earned his Juris Doctorate from the University of Minnesota Law School where he graduate with honors, known within the legal profession as the Order of the Coif; and

WHEREAS: In 1960, Stringer joined his father and practiced law with the law firm of Stringer, Donnelly and Sharood in St. Paul, where he focused on trial work, with an emphasis on railroad and insurance law and legal issues to small business; and

WHEREAS: In 1970, he joined Briggs and Morgan and became the firm's first managing partner in Minneapolis. During his 10 years with Briggs and Morgan, he focused on trade regulations and anti-trust litigation in a variety of industries. He has argued several cases before the federal court and the state court of appeals; and

WHEREAS: In 1980, Stringer moved to the Pillsbury Company where he headed-up the company's legal department and managed franchise litigation for several of the corporation's subsidiaries; and

WHEREAS: After nine years with Pillsbury, Stringer was appointed as general counsel for the U.S. Department of Education by President George Bush. During that time he wrote opinions and developed legal strategies on issues relating to school desegregation, special education, bilingual education, minority scholarships and higher education student loan programs; and

WHEREAS: Since 1991, he has served in Governor Carlson's administration, first as deputy chief of staff, and since 1992, as the Governor's chief of staff, where he served as chief advisor on the administration of government; and

WHEREAS: Ed Stringer will be sworn in on September 1, 1994, as the newest member of the Minnesota Supreme Court, appointed by Governor Arne H. Carlson; and

WHEREAS: Ed Stringer, with his navigational expertise and his ability to "read the stars", has helped to steer the Carlson Administration along the horizon toward success in 1994;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARNE H. CARLSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 20, 1994 to be

EDWARD C. STRINGER DAY

in Minnesota.
