**WHEREAS**, the said **Honorable Rosalie E. Wahl** has served as Associate Justice, Minnesota Supreme Court since October 4, 1977; and


**WHEREAS**, the said **Honorable Rosalie E. Wahl** has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of business on August 31, 1994;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, **ARNE H. CARLSON**, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the **Honorable Rosalie E. Wahl, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court**, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on August 31, 1994. She shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490. I hereby direct this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
